EXCLUSIVE WARRANTY CERTIFICATE

Libart North America Division of Stoett Industries, Inc. (Libart North America) warrants to the original consumer / purchaser (Purchaser) that such equipment supplied and installed by a Libart North America authorized distributor will be free from defect in materials and/or workmanship, in accordance with the conditions outlined below.

10 years, limited warranty: Within 10 years from date of delivery from the factory, any metal structure (extruded aluminum) for manufacturing defects.

10 years, PC manufacturers limited warranty: On all Polycarbonate (PC) glazing (with proper care - see attached manufacturer's warranty and maintenance care sheet).

5 years: Within 5 years from date of delivery from the factory any surface finishing against cracking and/or peeling and motor.

2 years: Within 2 years from date of delivery from the factory any accessories (door handles, wheels, locks, rollers, motor controls). Should such equipment prove to be defective, it shall be repaired or replaced by a Libart North America authorized distributor at Libart North America's discretion.

Disclaimers: Purchaser must pay all other labor and shipping charges necessary to repair or replace the equipment covered by this warranty. This warranty shall not apply to units that have been damaged by improper installation or maintenance, subjected to abuse or the addition/attachment of weighted items to the unit. This warranty shall not apply to units that have been altered or added to, or operated in a manner to cause undue stress or damage.

Exclusions : Units not installed as per the manufacturer's specifications and/or by an unauthorized distributor and damage due to conditions (snow and wind loads) outside of engineering design specifications identified or in contract are not covered under warranty and Libart North America is not responsible for any damage to the unit or subsequent structures. Libart North America will not cover under warranty units that have not been properly secured, operated and consequently damaged by wind, rain, snow, hail or ice. Libart North America will not cover under warranty units that have been damaged by snow or ice, and that have been installed at altitudes and in climate conditions that the units were not approved to go into. Libart North America shall not be liable for any consequential, incidental or contingent damages, whatsoever. Libart North America will not warranty or cover under warranty an enclosure on which solvents, abrasive cleaners, chemicals or scrubbing agents have been used or applied. Libart North America does not cover under warranty scratches to any metal, PC or acrylic surface.

Limited Warranty : Enclosures installed approximately one mile from bodies of salt water have a limited warranty of: 3 years on the finish and 5 years on the structural system There is no warranty from pitting or damage due to salt water or blowing sand.

Limitations : The foregoing warranties are exclusive and in lieu of all other express warranties, implied warranties, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchant ability and fitness for a particular purpose, and shall not extend beyond the duration of the applicable express warranties.

Legal Rights: Some Provinces / States do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages or limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state and province to province. Libart North America is not to be used as a childproofing enclosure or in place of any fence or barrier required by province / state, municipality, county or city.

What you must do to obtain Warranty Service:

1. Notify, in writing, the distributor from whom the Libart Enclosure was purchased. Explain the nature of the warranty claim and include proof of purchase with invoice and purchase date.
2. The distributor will document the claim and contact Libart North America to take appropriate action.
3. Decisions as to whether to repair, replace, or refund shall be made by Libart North America, in its sole discretion.
